

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

### NEOSALUS™

#### For Topical Dermatological Use Only

**Rx Only – Prescription Medical Device – Federal Law prohibits the sale of Device by, or on the order of, anyone other than a physician.**

#### DESCRIPTION

NEOSALUS is fragrance-free, water soluble foam dressing formulated for the management and relief of irritation experienced with various types of dermatoses, including atopic dermatitis and allergic contact dermatitis.

#### INGREDIENTS

Dimethicone, ethyl paraben, glycerine, methyl paraben, phenoxyethanol, polysorbate 20, polyvinylpyrrolidone, propylene glycol, propyl paraben, purified water, stearic acid, triethanolamine, butane and propane (propellants).

#### INDICATIONS FOR USE

NEOSALUS is indicated for management and relief of irritation associated with various types of dermatoses, including atopic dermatitis and allergic contact dermatitis.

#### CONTRAINDICATIONS

Known hypersensitivity to any of the NEOSALUS ingredients.

#### PRECAUTIONS

NEOSALUS is for external use only and should be used only as directed by a physician and should not be used to treat any condition other than that for which it is prescribed. NEOSALUS does not contain sunscreen and should not be used as such. If redness or irritation occurs, discontinue use and consult with prescribing physician.

KEEP THIS AND ALL OTHER MEDICATIONS OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.

#### DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

Unless otherwise directed by a prescribing physician, NEOSALUS should be applied to affected area three times a day (or as needed). NEOSALUS should be rubbed into the skin until it is completely absorbed.

#### HOW SUPPLIED

NEOSALUS is supplied in a 70 gram aerosolized canister bearing the NDC Number 23710-000-70 and a 200 gram aerosolized canister bearing the NDC Number 23710-000-02.

Store at controlled room temperature 15°-25°C (59°-77°F).
